January - June 2022 Outcome Results

Developing Potential has slowly returned to more normal on-site and off-site services. DPI continued to support some individuals and families who have not yet returned to in-person services by using the Telehealth program started in 2020 as a result of the COVID pandemic shutdown. We have returned to the community for many volunteer and other activities.

Outcome: People are able to choose health resources and are supported in making informed decisions regarding their health and well-being.

- *Percent of medications passed correctly during onsite services: 99%*
- *Number of trainings offered via the Relias Online Training platform: 260*
- *Number of Health -related training topic sessions for persons served : 18*
- *Number of individuals engaged in Healthy Cooking Club and met with dietitian: 40*



Outcome: People are satisfied with the services they are provided.

- *Percent of individuals/guardians who reported being satisfied with DPI services during annual planning meeting—100%.*
- *Percent of TCM Support Coordinators who report being satisfied with DPI services after Service Monitoring Visit: 100%*
- *Percent of Employers who report being satisfied with DPI Employment Connections: 100%*

Outcome: People are competitively employed in their community.

The DPI Employment Connections program supports 30 people who are competitively employed at local businesses including: Pizza Hut, Olive Garden, Main Event, Dollar Tree, and many others. DPI staff also support individuals who are working on skill development with a goal of employment.

- *Number of individuals who are competitively employed: 30*
- *Number of jobs held: 34 jobs*
- *Longest duration of secured employment—115 months*
